E2 BUS

Jefferson Parish Transit
\$2.00
45 - 60 minutes*

Cheap and slow; runs frequently.

BEGIN: Tulane Avenue & Loyola Avenue
END: Louis Armstrong Int'l Airport (MSY)

Jefferson Transit offers the E2 Bus to the airport. RTA fares and passes for the streetcar cannot be used for this bus service, but you can buy an additional pass to use.

Free street parking is available nearby on Erato Street, Carondelet Street, and Clio Street (the surrounding 3 blocks). Check signage to avoid being ticketed or towed. The closest paid lot is Premium Parking P139 at 928 Camp Street, a 7-minute walk away, it is ~\$25/day. P909 at 1339 Magazine St. is an 8-minute walk away and ~\$10/day. Both are outdoor lots.

202 Airport Express Bus

BEGIN: Union Passenger Terminal
END: Louis Armstrong Int'l Airport

Operates every 70 minutes and stops a 20-minute walk away from The Quisby at Union Passenger Terminal, which services Amtrak, Greyhound, Megabus, and city buses. The 202 takes you to the Departures Level at Louis Armstrong International Airport.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE

STREETCAR

New Orleans RTA
\$1.25 / one way
\$3 / 24-hour pass

Buy a one-way fare for \$1.25 or a 24-hour pass for \$3 directly on the bus or streetcar from the operator. You need exact change (we'll make it for you).

There are four streetcar lines that span New Orleans: the St. Charles line, the Canal Street line (both Cemeteries and City Park lines), the Riverfront line, and the newest Rampart line. All streetcar lines run along or intersect with Canal Street in the area between the Quarter and the Central Business District (CBD). We have maps at the Front Desk, too.

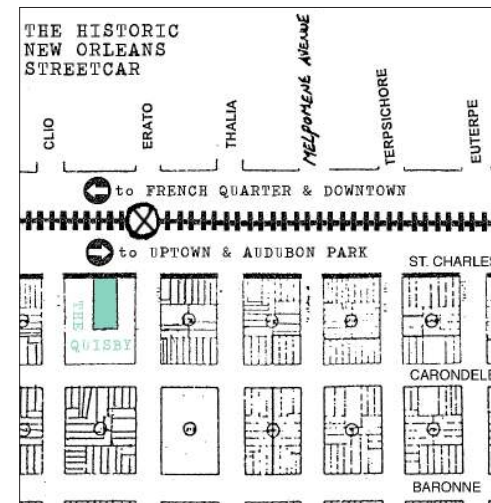

WALKING

Walking to the Quarter takes 20 minutes. During the day, take Carondelet to pass by some cool spots (Friend for menswear, Brother's for fried chicken) or walk down Erato and take a left on Camp to pass by the WWII Museum, the Ogden Museum, the Contemporary Arts Center, and Majoria's Commerce (a pristine 60's style breakfast joint) on the way to the Quarter.

FERRY

\$2 / one way

Take this commuter ferry for a quick ride across the Mississippi River and in five minutes you'll be in the second oldest neighborhood in New Orleans.

END: Algiers Point Ferry Terminal
